



3 Steps to Get Ready for Science

Welcome back! Whether you taught last spring in a classroom, remotely, or a bit of both, use this 3-step checklist to simplify opening your classroom for the new year.

1. Inventory and Prepare Your Kits

- Inventory kit materials
- Order missing or broken components
- Order refurbishments for consumable items



If your school or district purchased 3-use kits or refurbishment sets, you already may have additional consumables and living material prepaid coupons on site.

- Additional consumables are packed in a brown Carolina box labeled with kit name and "2nd-Use Box."
- Living material prepaid coupons are in a clear adhesive envelope attached to the 2nd-Use Box. If you cannot locate these coupons, contact Carolina's Customer Service at 800-123-4567.

2. Prepare for Your First Lesson
